Inmate Property Service (IPS)

The Inmate Property Service (IPS) commenced on 1 February 2016 under a new service model and is run by Prisoners' Aid Association (PAA).

IPS is designed for inmates (at the nominated centres) who cannot resolve their property storage needs in the community. MOSPs (Manager, Offender Services and Programs) at each of these nominated centres will be responsible for approving and managing all referrals to PAA for assistance.

What can be picked up?

- ✓ Clothing and associated personal items such as toiletries
- ✓ Electrical appliances or devices total weight not exceeding 15kg
- ✓ Small tools of trade
- ✓ Personal effects such as letters, documents, photographs
- ✓ Proof of Identity of documents e.g. Credit/Bank cards, passport, wallet.

What is the eligibility criterion?

- ✓ Inmates are currently housed at one of the nominated correctional centres
- ✓ Are otherwise unable to resolve their property collection or storage needs in the community.

Eligible inmates can have their property items stored by PAA while they are in custody. **The property must be collected within three months of release or it will be disposed of.**
