We have 11 standards which tell us how to work with children and families. They are:



Children have rights. We will listen to them and stand up for them.



We will be led by Aboriginal children, families and community to keep kids connected to their culture, family and Country.



We will learn from families about their culture and language. We will listen to children about what culture means to them.



We will be fair when we talk to children and their families, and when we write records.



We will keep children in contact with people they trust and can keep them safe.



We will see the strengths in children and people that love them.



We will think about our actions and beliefs and how they impact others.



We will work with parents and community to keep children safe.



We will ask children and the people who care for them for feedback so we can learn.



We will work with those who love and care about children.



Our leaders will set a good example and teach caseworkers how to do their job well.
